







9th graders win vs. Red Devils 54-43

■ Grayling posts 7-0 run in final two minutes to help seal the victory

Grayling High School won last Friday's freshman boys basketball home game vs. East Jordan 54-43 with help from a 7-0 run late in the fourth quarter.

The Vikings had a 20-11 lead after one quarter and led 31-16 at halftime.

Grayling took a 41-30 advantage into the fourth quarter.

Late in the fourth period, East Jordan pulled within four. Grayling then scored seven unanswered points – all on free throw shots (7 of 8) – to lead by 11, 52-41, with 26 seconds left in

the contest. The 7-0 run included free throw shots by Richard Schreiber (2 for 2), Josh Stapleton (2 for 2), and Matt McDonald (3 for 4).
